

PETITION

We, the undersigned property owners of Limpia Crossing, Ft. Davis, Texas, do hereby petition AT&T to comply with SB 560 of the 76th Legislature of the State of Texas which mandates that "customers in all regions of this state, including low-income customers and customers in rural and high cost areas, have access to advanced telecommunications and information services that are reasonably comparable to those services provided in urban areas and that are available at prices that are reasonably comparable to prices charged for similar services in urban areas."

The alternatives provided for either satellite transmission by AT&T subsidiary Wild Blue or for AT&T dial-up are in no way reasonably comparable in either service or price (see attached).

For many years we have been assured by SBC, now AT&T, that DSL service will soon be available in our area. Even though there appears to be a remote terminal in Limpia Crossing at the corner of Olds Creek and Clear View Drive, we are still being told that DSL service is not available to us.

We request that AT&T address this issue immediately, and that the Public Utility Commission enforce section 26.143 of the Public Utility Regulatory Act as approved at its April 18, 2002, open meeting which mandated making high speed broadband connection available to all.
